What does this mean?

You may receive a letter or phone call if your child's attendance falls below 96%.

We monitor children's attendance regularly to see if there are any patterns to absences, this could be illness, late, unauthorised absences.

### FACT

**School attendance is important because the law requires it. As a parent you are legally responsible for making sure your compulsory school age child gets a full-time education. This means making sure they attend regularly.**
