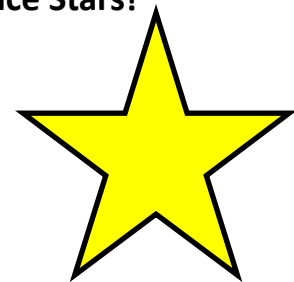

Well done to the following classes for their attendance last week.

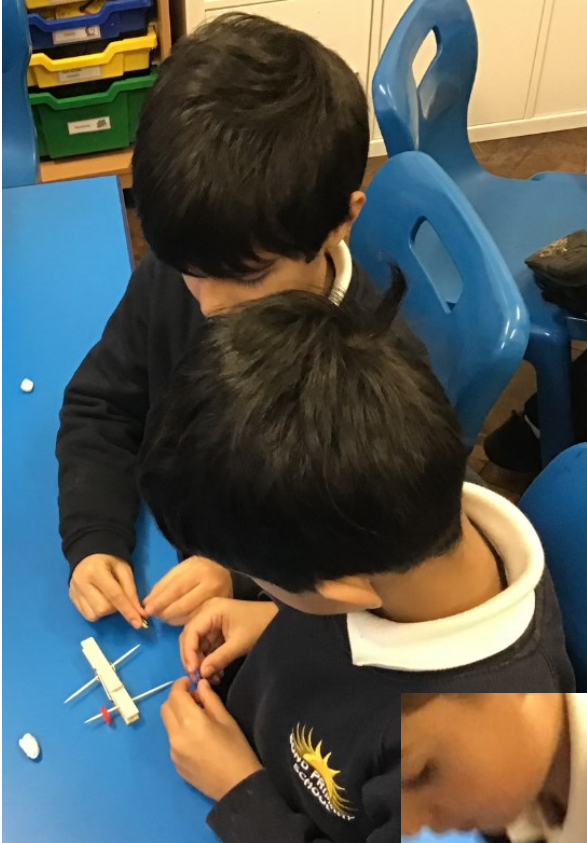

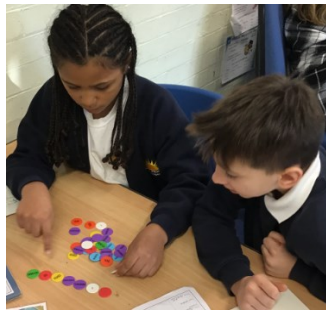
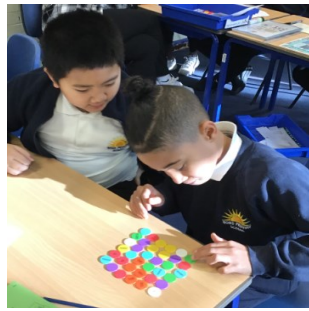
Key Stage Two
