Please check your child's hair regularly for headlice. Headlice is very common in children and can only be picked up by head to head contact. Headlice has nothing to do with having dirty hair. Headlice are small insects, up to 3mm long. They lay eggs (nits) which are brown or white and attached to strands of hair. 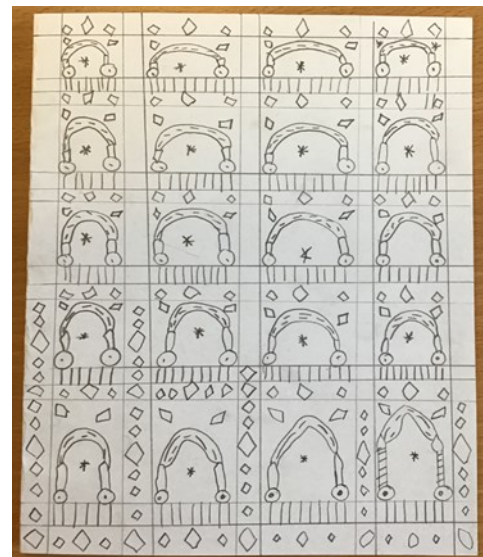
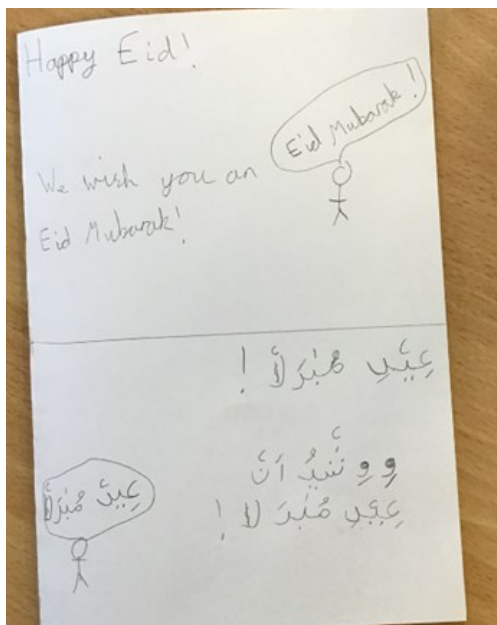


## Pop Up Fidget Toys

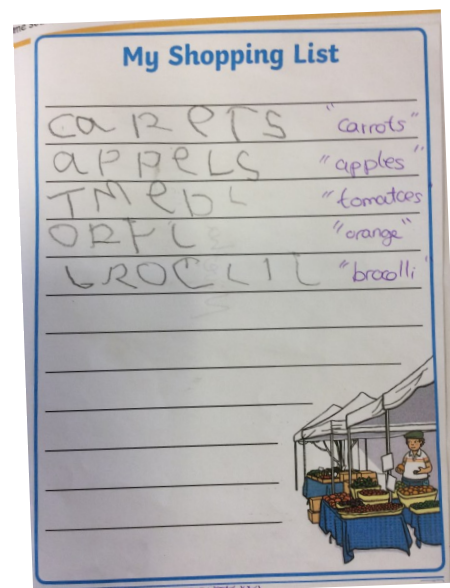
A number of children are bringing fidget toys to school. Fidget resources are only given to specific children across the school. Please ensure that your child does not bring a fidget toy to school.
