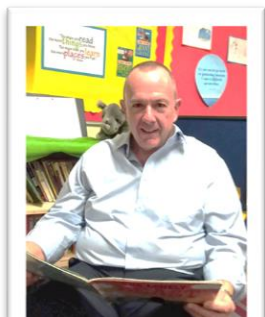
Co Vice Chair, Co-opted Governor- Alice Boaten
