Dear Parents / Carers and Children

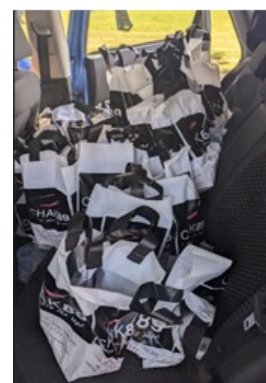




**Task 1**  
**Food – preparing fruit and vegetables** – follow health and safety  
 The year 1 children made fruit cups for the Bond Carnival (Summer 2).  
 They decided on what they wanted to make as a class. They chose the fruit which would be in the fruit cups, by tasting fruit.  
 When they were ready, they started to prepare the fruit cups.  
 1. They washed their hands, ready to work with food.  
 2. They washed the fruit to be used in the fruit cups.  
 3. They used chopping boards and safe knives to cut and peel the fruit.  
 4. All of the children had an opportunity to contribute to the making of the food cups.  
 5. Evaluation: The children tasted the fruit cups.  
 6. Fruit cups were presented at the carnival to buy.

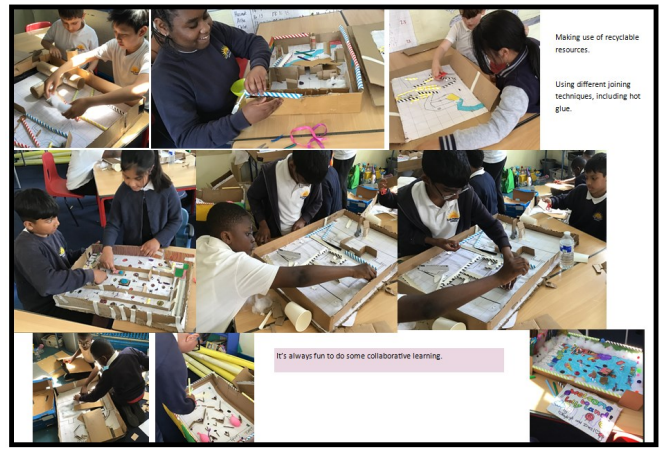
**Textiles – 2D shape to 3D shape products**
