Co Vice-Chair, Co-opted Governor Afua Boateng Busia

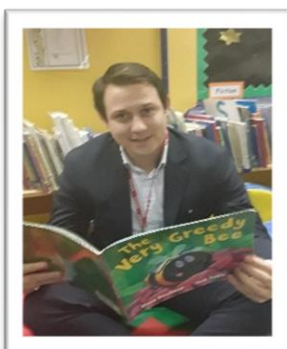
I am a retired mother and grandmother who is very passionate about education, both formal and informal. I love working with and for young people.
