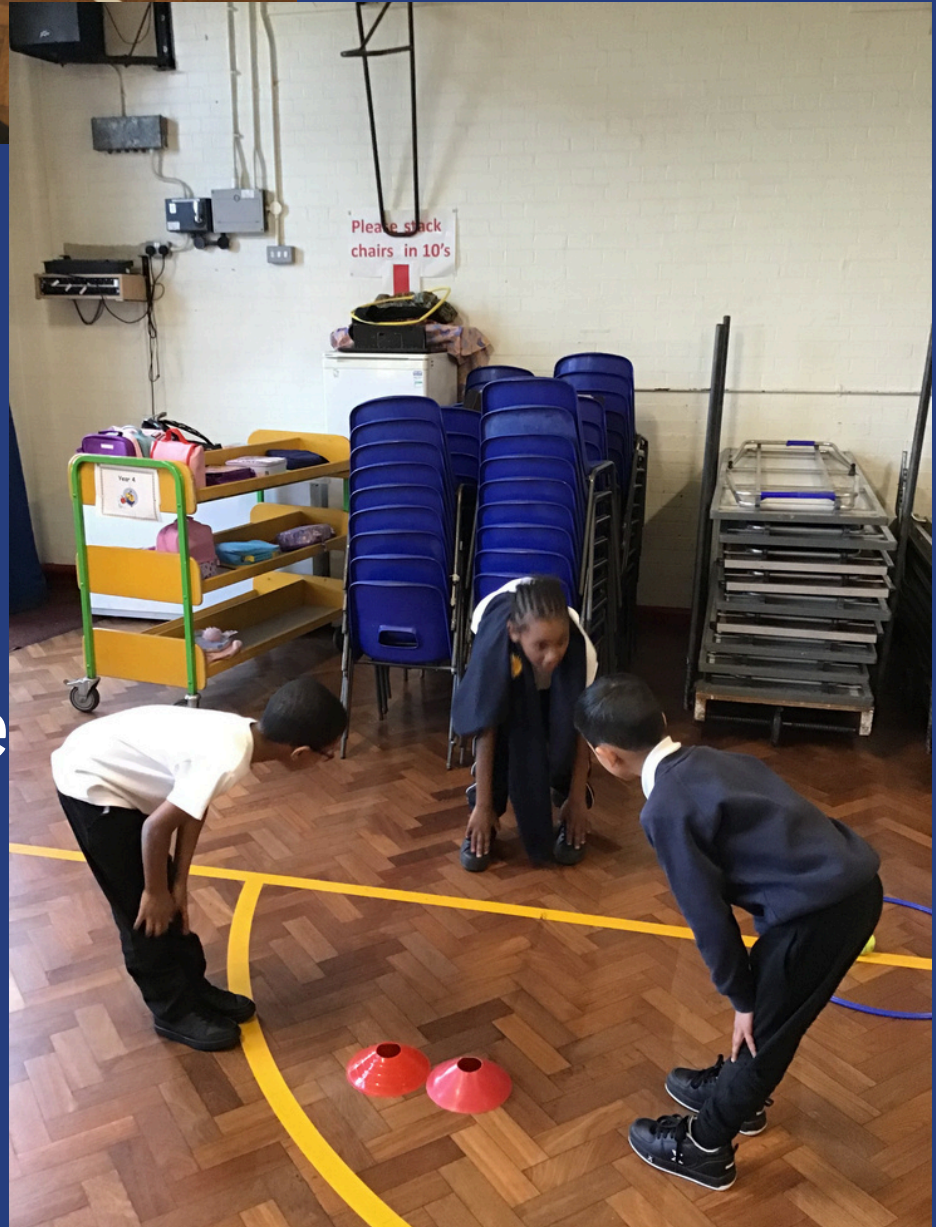

What is Boccia?

Boccia (pronounced bot-cha) is a sport similar to bowls. It is a target ball sport which tests both muscle control and accuracy. The term boccia derives from the Italian word meaning "bowl" and on the continent bowls is often referred to as Bocce.
