Message from the Headteacher

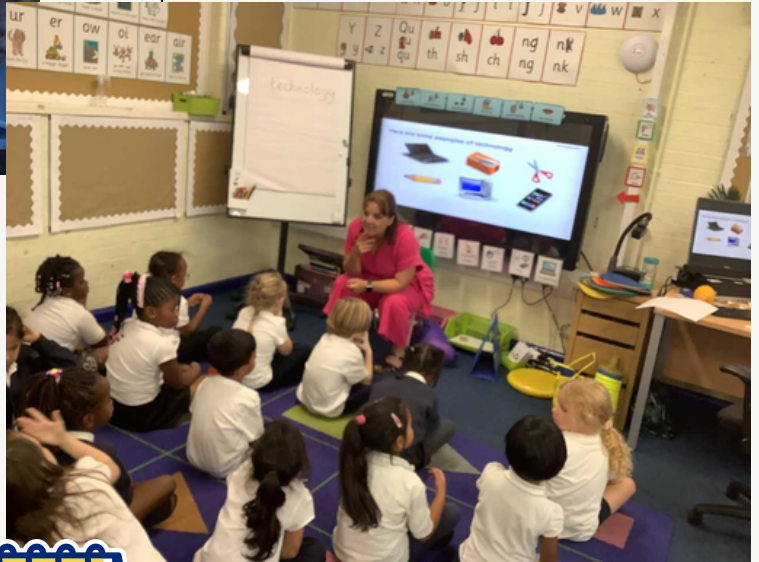
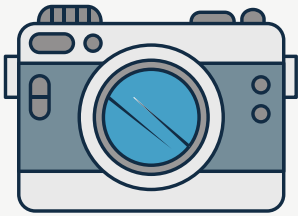
