A huge thank you to those of you that attended the EYFS parent workshop. We have lots more workshops and open mornings planned for you to really get a feel for our school in action.

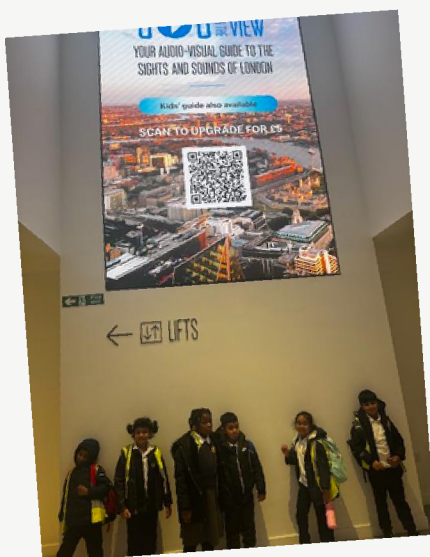
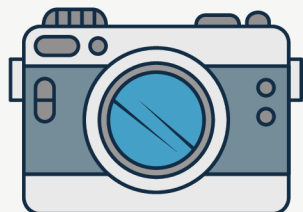
